# Quick start guide

Philips Bluetooth stereo headset SHB1400



### Charge your headset

1 Remove the USB cap.



2 Plug the headset into a powered USB port for charging. Red LED will turn off after the headset is fully charged.



### Fit your headset

Place the earbud in your ear, and rotate the headset upwards or downwards until it fits securely.




#### **Optional**

For an extra-secure fit, attach the earhook: Push the ball joint between the earbud and the main body of the headset. Adjust the earhook for providing the best fit.



# Make sure to "pair" your new Philips headset with your cell phone before you use it for the first time

- 1 Ensure that the headset is charged and turned off.
- 2 Ensure that the mobile phone is turned on and its Bluetooth feature is activated.
- 3 Press ( until the LED starts flashing red and blue alternately. Do not stop pressing the button after seeing the blue LED only.
- 4 Pair the headset with the mobile phone. For details, refer to the user manual of the mobile phone.

## Using your headset

Turn headset on/off	Press 🕻 until LED turns on/off.
Check battery	Hold <b>VOL +</b> and <b>VOL -</b> simultaneously. > 50%: 1 blue flash < 50%: 2 red flashes < 25%: 3 red flashes
Pick up/ end a call	Press (.
Adjust volume	Press VOL +/ VOL
Redial the last number	Press (* twice quickly.
Reject a call	Hold (.
Activate voice dialing	Hold ( until beep occurs.
Transfer call to mobile phone	Hold ( while on a call.
Mute the Mic	Press ( twice quickly during a call.

### LED and sound indication

The red/blue LED flashes alternately.	The headset is ready for pairing.
The blue LED flashes once every 3 seconds.	The headset is connected to the phone.
The red LED flashes twice every 5 seconds.	The headset is not connected.
The blue LED flashes once every half a second.	There is an incoming/outgoing call.
The blue LED flashes once every second.	The headset is active on a call.
The red LED flashes three times and beeps twice every minute.	The battery is low in power.
Solid red LED	The headset is charging.
The LED is off.	The headset is off./Charging is finished.
The headset beeps every 5 seconds	The Mic is muted.
